Opening prayer, U.S. Pledge of Allegiance, & New Mexico Pledge.

Agenda: Rick Ledbetter moved to approve the agenda as presented. Mitzi Miller seconded. Motion carried.

Minutes: Mitzi Miller moved to approve the August 10, 2023 meeting minutes as presented. Rick Ledbetter seconded. Motion carried.

<u>Financial Reports & Bills:</u> Mitzi Miller moved to approve the financial reports for filing and bills for payment. Rick Ledbetter seconded. Motion carried. (See attached.)

NRCS Report: D'Llaynn Bruce presented the NRCS report. New office furniture should be delivered next week.

NMDA Report: Dean Bruce presented the NMDA Report.

<u>Review Mail:</u> The mail was reviewed. The Board discussed information provided on a possible rain-catchment program to harvest rainwater.

<u>Weather Program:</u> George Bomar discussed possible funding through the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA). Mitzi Miller moved to hire George to draft a grant application for funding for our Weather Program. Rick Ledbetter seconded. Motion carried.

Charlie Marquez provided a presentation on our cloud-seeding program and our funding needs/requests for the District. He will use this to discuss funding requests from legislators.

A meeting has been scheduled for tomorrow between Mike Cone, Rick Ledbetter, Charlie Marquez, and Nathan Small.

Charlie is also planning on meeting with the Mescalero Tribe regarding a possible winter cloud-seeding program.

Mitzi Miller moved to accept the contract between Roosevelt SWCD and Broad Spectrum Consulting. Kendell Buzard seconded. Motion carried.

<u>Shade Ball Water Conservation Project:</u> Sam Smallidge was in attendance and discussed the shade ball wildlife research project. The District is looking for a college student to assist with the project. Sam will meet with board members in the next few weeks to start getting cameras set up on sites.

Rick Ledbetter moved that Roosevelt SWCD place an order for 104,000 shade balls. Kendell Buzard seconded. Motion carried.

Rick Ledbetter moved to place an order of 104,000 shade balls to be shipped directly to Williams Ranch in Fort Stockton, Texas, at a price of \$.54 per ball, with a 50% deposit due at the time of order and remainder on delivery. Mitzi Miller seconded. Motion carried.

Roosevelt SWCD is waiting for an estimate from the contractor to begin construction on our shade ball storage building.

The 2024 Budget adjustment for the purchase of shade balls was tabled until next month.

<u>Playa Lakes Restoration Project:</u> Kendell Buzard moved to accept the MOA between Roosevelt SWCD & the NM State Land Office. Mitzi Miller seconded. Motion carried.

<u>High Plains CWMA:</u> The 2024 Budget adjustment to include the WQ&C funding for our noxious weed program was discussed. Approval was tabled until next month.

Well Monitoring: Repairs will be made to the well monitor in October on their next visit to Portales.
